## Answers to Part II of Test Your Bible Knowledge

1. **D** Samuel. See 1 Samuel 1:20
2. **D**. Seth. Eve said God "appointed me another seed instead of Abel, whom Cain slew." See Genesis 4:25
3. **B**. Jochebed. After hiding him for three months, Jochebed put Moses in an "ark of bulrushes" by the river. When the pharaoh's daughter found the basket, Miriam, Moses' sister, stepped forward and offered to find a Hebrew nurse of the child. Jochebed was paid to nurse her own son until he was weaned. See Exodus 2:2-10 and Exodus 6:20.
4. **B**. Manasseh. Forcing his son to pass through fire was just one of Manasseh's many wicked deeds that angered the Lord. Manasseh also "used enchantments, and dealt with familiar spirits and wizards." See 2 Kings 21:1-6
5. **C**. Gomer and Hosea. Gomer was Hosea's wife, not daughter. See Hosea 1:2-4. For other daughter-father pairs, see Genesis 29:16, 1 Samuel 18:17, and 1 Kings 16:31.
6. **B**. Mahlon and Chilion. The sons married two women of Moab, Ruth, and Orpah. See Ruth 1:2-4
7. **D**. Abraham. See Genesis 22:1-18 and James 2:21-22.

8. **C.** Keturah. After Sarah's death, Abraham took Keturah as a wife. She gave birth to six sons, including Midian, Ancestor of the Midianites. See Genesis 25:1-2
9. **B.** John. As a sort of last will and testament, Jesus asked from the cross that his disciple John look after his mother, saying, "Woman, behold thy son" to Mary and "behold thy mother" to John. John took Mary into his own home. See John 19:26-27
10. **B.** To sit her sons on Jesus' right and left hands in the kingdom. See Matthew 20:20-21
11. **B.** Gabriel. See Luke 1:26-32
12. **D.** Bathsheba and Solomon. See 2 Samuel 12:24; (Cf. Matthew 1:6). Later, in 1 Chronicles 3:5, Solomon's mother is called Bathshua.
13. **A.** True. Lot was the father of two of his grandchildren - Moab and Benammi. To preserve the seed of their father, both of Lot's daughters each had a son by him. See Genesis 19:36-38.
14. **C.** **Ishmael**. Because Abraham's wife, Sarah, could not bear a child, she offered her maid, Hagar, as a surrogate. Hagar gave birth to Ishmael. See Genesis 16:15.
15. **C.** Joseph and Manasseh. See Genesis 41:51.
16. **B.** Judah. Tamar disguised herself, pretended to be a harlot, and lured her father-in-law, Judah. Tamar demanded Judah's signet as a pledge of payment. A pregnant Tamar was brought before Judah for punishment. When Judah saw his signet and realized he was the father, he repented. See Genesis 38:6-26.



17. **A.** Samson. Samson's mother was instructed not to drink wine or eat unclean things during her pregnancy. And once her son was born, no razor was ever to be used on Samson's head. See Judges 13:2-24.
18. **B.** False. Jacob favored Joseph more than Reuben and all his children, as he was the "son of his old age." See Genesis 37:1-3.
19. **A.** Rebekah. See Genesis 35:23-26.
20. **B.** Jacob and Esau. When the once-barren Rebekah finally conceived, the children "struggled together within her." The Lord told Rebekah that there were two nations in her womb, and the one people would be stronger than the other, and the elder would serve the younger. See Genesis 25:21-26.
21. **B.** False. After raping Dinah, Shechem told his father to "Get me this damsel to wife." Hamor suggested to Jacob that their tribes intermarry. Jacob's sons, furious that their sister had been defiled, demanded all males in Hamor's tribe be circumcised before they could marry Israelite women. Three days after the circumcisions, Dinah's brothers killed Shechem, Hamor, all the men of their city. See Genesis 34:1-26.
22. **A.** True. See Acts 16:1
23. **B.** Bethlehem. See Ruth 1:19

24. **D.** Fishers. James and John, the sons of Zebedee, were fishermen. James and John were in a ship with their father mending their nets when called by Jesus. See Matthew 4:21.

25. **B.** False. The sons of Bilhah, Rachel's handmaid, were Dan and Naphtali. Gad and Asher were the sons of Zilpah, Leah's handmaid. See Genesis 35:25-26.
