1. D. Solomon. See 1 Kings 10:26
2. C. Silas. The prophet Silas appears in the New Testament only. See Acts 15:32.
3. C. 490. See Matthew 18:21-22
4. D. Deborah. See Judges 4:4
5. A. Dorcas. The disciple Tabitha, who is also called Dorcas is described as a woman "full of good works and almsdeeds." See Acts 9:36.
6. D. Zaphnath-paaneah. See Genesis 41:45.
7. A. Israel. See Genesis 35:10
8. C. Aquila and Priscilla. See Acts 18:1-2
9. C. 300. In addition to 300 concubines, King Solomon had 700 wives. See 1 Kings 11:3.
10. A. Seven sons and three daughters. See Job 1:1-2
11. B. Elihu. See Job 32
12. B. Jesus. The shortest Bible verse is just two words: "Jesus wept." See John 11:35.

13. C. Gabriel. The angel Gabriel appeared to Zacharias and told him that his wife, Elisabeth, would bear a son to be named John. See Luke 1:13, 19.
14. A. Eli. After Samuel was born and weaned, his mother Hannah brought him to Shiloh to serve with Eli. See 1 Samuel 1:24-25.
15. A. Zimri. See 1 Kings 16:15. Zimri burned down the palace in 1 Kings 16:18 and died in the fire.
16. D. Mordecai. When Esther's parents died, an older cousin named Mordecai took her in and raised her as his own daughter. See Esther 2:7.
17. A. Methuselah. Methuselah lived to be 969 years old. See Genesis 5:27.
18. A. True. Jared, the second-oldest man in the Bible, lived to the age of 962. See Genesis 5:20
19. C. Nebuchadnezzar. He was driven from men and ate grass "like oxen." See Daniel 4:33.
20. C. Maher-shalhash-baz. See Isaiah 8:1.
21. B. Og. See Numbers 21:33
22. A. Jezebel. See 1 Kings 16:31
23. B. Three. Jesus raised three people from the dead. (1) Jesus raised the son of a widow woman from Nain when He encountered the funeral procession. (2) He raised the 12-year-old daughter of Jairus. (3) Finally, Jesus raised his friend Lazarus, the brother of Mary and Martha. See Luke 7:11-15, 8:41-56; Matthew 9:18-25; Mark 5:21-42; and John 11:1-44.

25. D. Abraham. See Luke 16:19-31
