Note: Here is the information you need to calculate and convert the distance of Threescore Furlongs into Miles - Question #3 above.

1. First, in Scripture, the term "score" equals twenty (20). Therefore, Threescore furlongs would equal

3 x 20 or 60 Furlongs.

- A furlong equals 1/8 of a mile or 220 Yards.
- One (1) mile = 1760 Yards or 5280 Feet

2. With this information, to determine how many miles does 60 Furlongs equal, lets work with converting 60 furlongs into yards.

- Multiply 60 furlongs times 220 Yards

$$60 \times 220 = 13,200 \text{ Yards}$$

3. We now know that 60 furlongs equal 13, 200 Yards. We also know that there are 1760 Yards in one (1) mile. Therefore, let's divide 13,200 Yards by 1760 Yards and our answer will result in miles.

- 13,200 = 7.5 Miles

1760

So, the answer to the nearest mile (dropping any portion above or below a whole mile) for Question #3 in the Quiz, would be 7 Miles.
