Bible Study - June 9, 2022

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Title: The Supremacy and Adequacy of Christ

Scripture Reference: Colossians 2:9-10

“For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power”

I. Introduction

A. Our Bible Study for this session will involve exercising and stretching our minds for the Lord Jesus Christ as we will delve into the Book of Colossians and come to appreciate evermore that the Lord Jesus Christ is completely sufficient for all of our needs.

F. The material that follows is a 16 by 16 Word Search block, and if you stick with it, you will be able to locate each word that's listed in the Word List. When you locate a word from the Word

List, draw a circle around the complete word in the word block.

G. Also, what I am about to suggest is not mandatory to successfully complete the Word Search, but if you have a couple of assorted color "highlighters" (markers), you may want to highlight the words as you locate them in the block. This is only a suggestion; the key point to is locate the words and place a circle around each word as you located it.
